



Information in accordance with Article 13 EU-General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

DATA PROCESSING PURPOSES AND LEGAL BASIS:

We process personal data in conformity with the provisions of the European General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) as well as the national data protection acts:

- a.) For the performance of contractual obligations/within the scope of contract execution (Article 6 para 1 b EU-GDPR)
The processing of data is carried out for the purpose of fulfilling or executing contractual obligations or for the performance of precontractual measures. The further details concerning the data processing purposes can be taken from the contractual documents which are relevant for the contractual relationship including the corresponding annexes. In course of the contract execution ECE might also process personal data to fulfill legal requirements.
- b.) Based on your consent (Article 6 para 1a EU GDPR)
If you have given us consent to the processing of your personal data for certain purposes, the lawfulness of such processing exists on the basis of your consent. Any consent given may be withdrawn at any time. The withdrawal of the consent does not affect the lawfulness of the data processed up to the withdrawal.
- c.) Within the framework of the weighing of interests (Article 6 para 1 f EU-GDPR)
As far as necessary, we process your data also to secure our legitimate interests or the legitimate interests of third parties.
Examples:
 - Assertion of legal claims and defence in legal disputes
 - Securing of IT safety and IT operation

DATA CATEGORIES:

We process the following categories of data - **in each case dependant on the specific type of contract/ agreement and the individual processing purpose / the relevant legal basis:** master data, address and contact data, ID data, settlement data, contractual data, financial data, technical data and communication data.

RECIPIENTS:

Your data will in some cases- **dependant on the specific type of contract/agreement and individual processing purpose / the relevant legal basis** - be passed on to contractual partners. The contracting parties originate from the following categories: Marketing, newsletters, security, IT services, communications, credit services, printing services, telecommunications, public authorities, financial services, insurance.

ECE uses for certain tasks service providers who in most cases likewise use service providers who may have their registered office, parent company or data centres in a third country. Any transfer is admissible if the European Commission has decided that there is an adequate safety level in a third country (Article 45 GDPR). If the Commission has not taken any such decision, ECE or the service provider may only transfer personal data to a third country or an international organisation if appropriate guarantees are provided (e.g. standard data protection clauses) which are accepted by the Commission or the supervisory authority in a specific procedure) and enforceable rights and effective legal remedies are available.

DURATION OF STORAGE:

For the execution of a contract, based on your consent or to secure legitimate interests, your personal data are stored. If you withdraw, however, your consent / oppose data processing in a legally effective manner or the purpose for the processing no longer exists because the storage is no longer necessary to fulfil our contractual and statutory obligations (and there are no other statutory obligations / rights in respect of storage), the data are erased.

RIGHTS OF DATA SUBJECTS:

Every data subject has the right to information in accordance with Article 15 GDPR, a right to rectification in accordance with Article 16 GDPR, a right to erasure in accordance with Article 17 GDPR, a right to restriction of processing in accordance with Article 18 GDPR, a right to object based on Article 21 GDPR as well as a right to data portability under Article 20 GDPR. Moreover, there is a right to lodge a complaint with the competent supervisory authority (Article 77 GDPR).

You can withdraw any consent to the processing of personal data granted to us at any time. Please note that the withdrawal only becomes effective for the future. Any processing made before the withdrawal is not affected.

Moreover, you have the right, for reasons resulting from your special situation, to oppose at any time the processing of data concerning you which is made by virtue of Article 6 para 1 lit. e (performance of a task carried out in the public interest) or Article 6 para 1 lit. f GDPR (legitimate interests of the controller); this also applies for any profiling based on these provisions. In this case we no longer process data concerning you unless we can demonstrate compelling legitimate grounds for the processing which override your interests, rights and freedoms or if the processing serves the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims.

If any data concerning you are processed to carry out direct marketing, you have the right to oppose the processing of such data for marketing purposes at any time. If you oppose the processing for direct marketing purposes, such data are no longer processed for these purposes.
